

# CLARK COUNTY STAFF REPORT

**DEPARTMENT:** Public Works, Engineering & Construction Division

**DATE:** April 7, 2020

**REQUESTED ACTION:** Approve Notice to Contractors to advertise for bids for the Smith Bridge No. 211 project located on Northeast 167th Avenue 0.25 mile south of Northeast 199th Street. CRP No. 381522.

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## BACKGROUND

Clark County engineers routinely inspect the condition of each bridge in the county's transportation network. This includes the condition of streambed erosion (scour) adjacent to the bridge foundations. In 2007, Clark County's Scour Critical Bridge Review grouped the 34 scour-critical bridges in order to develop an action plan. The high priority locations have been addressed and the county continues to seek funding for the other scour critical locations.

A federal grant has been received for Smith Bridge No. 211, a medium priority scour-critical bridge. The project will provide improvements by installing scour countermeasures at the bridge. This work will include excavating existing material surrounding the bridge abutments and replacing it with buried rock covered by streambed gravels. Temporarily impacted areas will be replanted with native trees, shrubs and grasses.

Project plans and specifications are complete and the project is ready for bidding. The project will be advertised for bids once WSDOT funding approval is received (anticipated in April).

## COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project supports the council's policy of investing in maintenance of the county road system, providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

## ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program, 2020 Annual Construction Program (No. 17) and the 2020 Budget.

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is listed in the adopted 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program and adopted 2020 Annual Construction Program. Community outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program included two work sessions and a hearing with the Clark County Council, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, Regional Transportation Advisory Committee, and the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, completion of a State Environmental Policy Act review, and targeted outreach to neighborhood groups and other stakeholders.

Project information mailers were sent to residents in the area and the project team has met with property owners impacted by the project. Public Works will provide additional community outreach by mailing newsletters to residents in the vicinity of the project informing them of the project and how it might affect drivers.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on \_\_\_\_\_, 2020 for: **CRP No. 381522, Smith Bridge #211**, on NE 167<sup>th</sup> Avenue 0.25 mile south of NE 199<sup>th</sup> Street.

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This project will provide improvements at Smith Bridge #211 by constructing scour mitigation countermeasures, work which includes creek diversion, excavation of existing material, installation of rock and streambed material, and restoration of disturbed areas.

Primary bid items: Channel Excavation Incl. Haul, Bank Restoration, Temporary Stream Diversion, Irrigation System and Water, Rock for Erosion and Scour Protection Class A.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the

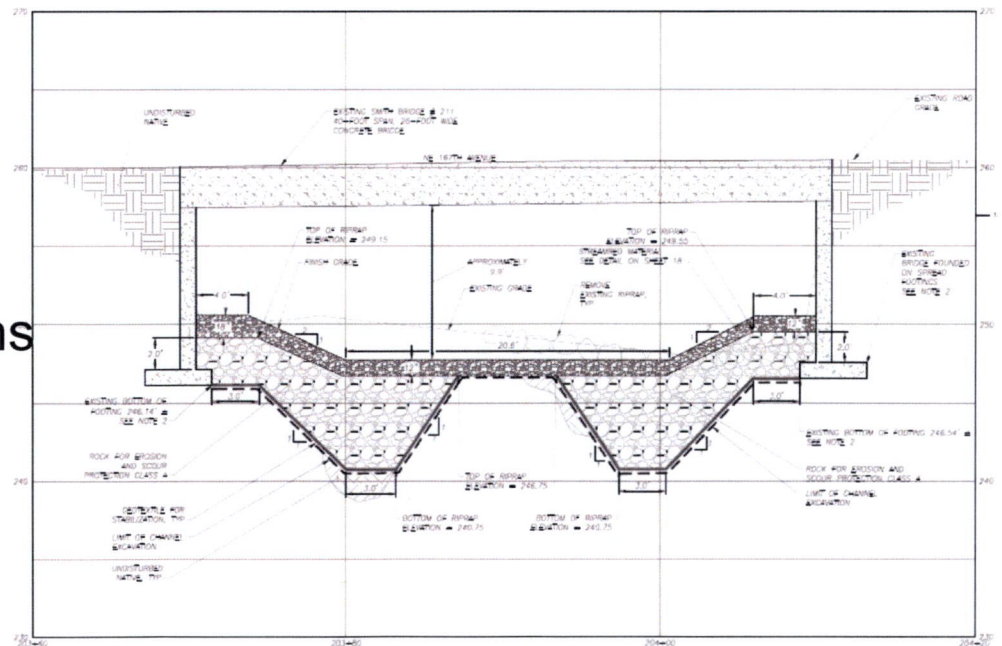
# Smith Bridge #211 Council District 4
