REQUESTED ACTION: Approve attached notices to advertise summaries of construction projects completed with county forces in 2019 and listing projects to be built with county forces in 2020.

BACKGROUND

To be in compliance with RCW 36.77.070 and maintain our Good Standards of Practice with the County Road Administration Board, Clark County must publish annual notices regarding the use of county forces on Public Works projects.

The first attached notice summarizes the use of county forces in 2019 and the actual cost of this work. The second notice summarizes the planned use of county forces in 2020 and the estimated cost of this work.

Council approval will authorize publication of both notices.

None. This project supports the council's policy of providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

Outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) included two work sessions and a hearing with the Clark County Council, and presentations to Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, and neighborhood associations. The TIP was also displayed and discussed at several public open houses, at the Clark County Fair and on the county website. A State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) review provided an additional opportunity for public comment.

RCW 36.77.070

Publication of information on county forces projects—Penalty—Prosecution.

If the board determines that any construction should be performed by county forces, and the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten thousand dollars, it shall cause to be published in one issue of a newspaper of general circulation in the county, a brief description of the work to be done and the county road engineer's estimate of the cost thereof. At the completion of such construction, the board shall cause to be published in one issue of such a newspaper a similar brief description of the work together with an accurate statement of the true and complete cost of performing such construction by county forces.

Failure to make the required publication shall subject each county commissioner to a fine of one hundred dollars for which he or she shall be liable individually and upon his or her official bond and the prosecuting attorney shall prosecute for violation of the provisions of this section and RCW 36.77.065.
