**REQUESTED ACTION:** Approve Notice to Contractors to advertise for bids for the Highway 99 Corridor Improvements Project (Project No. 351022).

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## BACKGROUND

Clark County applied for and received a \$2 million federal Surface Transportation Program grant to improve congestion, mobility, and safety at the intersection of Northeast Highway 99 and Northeast 99th Street. The project will also use \$500 thousand in Traffic Impact Fees.

The Highway 99 Corridor Improvements project includes the following:

### Highway 99

- Add and widen sidewalks
- Widen the southbound right-turn lane to 13 feet
- Continue the southbound bike-lane to Northeast 99th Street
- Consolidate two driveways into one (Highway 99 Center)
- Install a median north of Northeast 99th Street
- Adjust the C-Tran Bus Shelter (C-Tran will remove and replace)

### Northeast 99th Street

- Widen the westbound receiving lanes from 10 feet to 12.5 feet
- Add and widen sidewalks
- Relocate and extend the median on Northeast 99th Street
- Widen eastbound left-turn lane from 10 feet to 11.5 feet

### Northeast 13th Ave

- Add a left-turn pocket for Northeast 13th Avenue from Eastbound Northeast 99th Street
- Add channelization allowing only right-in and right-out on southbound Northeast 13th Avenue

### Highway 99 Sub-Area Plan

- Add a bench, waste receptacle, and bike rack

The contractor will need to close Northeast 99th Street for a short duration. Alternative routes will be available.

**COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

None. The project is included in the 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program, 2020 Annual Construction Program and the 2020 budget.

**ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

**COMMUNITY OUTREACH**

Heads Up notices were sent out to the surrounding community in 2017 and 2018. Open houses were held in July 2018 and September 2018. Public Works will send out another Heads Up notice to the surrounding community prior to the start of construction. Specific closure dates and alternate route information will be provided to the public in accordance with RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction. Variable message signs will alert drivers for five days prior to the start of the closure and will continue to inform drivers of the affected intersection approaches during closure. Public Works will send out a mailer to residents near the closure before the start of construction.

Public Works will issue a news release and post information on its website, including a map showing how drivers can bypass construction, prior to the start of the road closure. Public Works will notify emergency responders and coordinate with other stakeholders as needed.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on \_\_\_\_\_, 2020 for: **CRP No. 351022, Highway 99 and Northeast 99th Street Intersection.**

**Please Note:** While bids are typically opened on Tuesday, Clark County has moved this bid opening to Wednesday to accommodate the Memorial Day weekend.

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This project will demo approximately 16 feet of the northwest corner of Highway 99 and Northeast 99<sup>th</sup> Street, reconstruct the radius in the new location. Widen the two westbound lanes of Northeast 99<sup>th</sup> street and the right-turn lane on the southbound Highway 99, Relocate Fire Hydrant(s), install storm lines, median, and install new mast arm and signal, tree removal.

Primary bid items: HMA Cl. 3/8 In. PG58H22; Cement Concrete Class 3000 and 4000; Planing Bituminous Pavement, Traffic Control, Portable Changeable Message Sign, Temporary Speed Bump, Temporary Chain Link Fence,

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to


