AUGUST 1, 2017 PRIMARY AND SPECIAL ELECTION **- BALLOTS IN THE MAIL** **- ELECTION NIGHT RESULTS**

Ballots for the upcoming August 1 primary and special election will be mailed to registered voters starting Friday, July 14. For this election, only voters in city of Camas Ward 1, city of La Center, city of Vancouver, city of Washougal, city of Woodland, town of Yacolt, Evergreen School District, Hockinson School District, Vancouver School District, Clark Regional Wastewater District, Clark County Fire & Rescue and Clark County Emergency Medical Service District No. 1 will receive a ballot.

If a voter does not receive his or her mail ballot by Thursday, July 20, he or she should contact the Elections Office at **(360) 397-2345** and request a replacement ballot. Replacement ballots can be requested in person at 1408 Franklin Street in Vancouver, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. A voter may also request a replacement ballot by email or by mail. Our email address is elections@clark.wa.gov and our mailing address is Clark County Elections Department, PO Box 8815, Vancouver, WA 98666-8815.

At 6 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, August 1, the process of entering the scanned ballot information into the ballot tabulation system will begin. Election results will be released to the public and news media on the 1st floor of the Public Service Center in the Dragon Fly Café at 1300 Franklin Street, Vancouver, at or before 8:15 p.m. as well as being available on the County Auditor's website at clarkvotes.org.
