February special election logic and accuracy test scheduled for January 9, 2018

Vancouver, WA – At 10 am on Tuesday, Jan. 9, the Clark County Elections Office will conduct a logic and accuracy test of the programming to be used to tabulate ballots and the accessible voting units for the Feb. 13 special election.

The test will be held at the Clark County Elections Office, 1408 Franklin St., Vancouver. Members of the news media, jurisdictions with measures on the ballot and the public are invited to attend this test, which is required under Washington law.

Ballots will be mailed Friday, Jan. 26.

For this election, registered voters in Battle Ground School District, Evergreen School District, La Center School District and the city of Camas will receive ballots.

At 6 pm Election Day, Tuesday, Feb. 13, the process of entering the scanned ballot information into the ballot tabulation system will begin.
