April 24, 2018 Special Election Voter Registration Deadlines

Vancouver, WA – The last day to submit a mail-in voter registration form to be eligible to vote in the April 24 special election is Monday, March 26.

Online registration applications can be submitted up to 11:59 pm Monday, March 26. Visit the Elections Office website at clarkvotes.org and click on *MyVote* to register online.

Current registered voters who wish to change their address online must do so before midnight on Monday, March 26, for the April 24 special election. The Clark County Elections Office will be open until 5 pm Monday, March 26, to accept address changes made by telephone or in person.

Citizens who are not currently registered to vote in the state of Washington have additional time and may register to vote by appearing in person at the **Clark County Elections Office, 1408 Franklin Street, Vancouver** through Monday, April 16.

Only registered voters in Battle Ground School District will receive ballots for this election.

An online voters' guide will be available starting March 19 by visiting the Elections Office website at clarkvotes.org.
