- 24 hour crisis phone line that provides information, referral and advocacy
- Support in identifying and prioritizing the emergency needs
- Assistance in obtaining services to enhance healing and recovery

- Support during investigative and legal processes

LEGAL RIGHTS - We will listen to you and help you understand your rights.

MEDICAL SUPPORT - We will be present with you at the hospital and provide on-going support.

SAFETY PLANNING - We will help you develop a plan for increasing your safety at home, work, school and other places you visit.

RESOURCES & SERVICES - We will do everything we can to provide you with resources and services to help you re-establish your life.

CRISIS INTERVENTION - We provide help you can access on a 24-hour hotline anytime for any crime.
