# Influenza-Like Illness Report Form

## Instructions:

Please use this worksheet to report when your school observes  $\geq 10\%$  (of total population) absenteeism among staff/students resulting from influenza-like illness (ILI) or clusters of particularly severe respiratory infections (per WAC 246-110-020).

Influenza most commonly occurs between October and May, but outbreaks and sporadic cases can occur during any time of the year.

- ➔ ILI is defined as a fever  $\geq 100.0^{\circ}\text{F}$  and a cough or sore throat (in the absence of a known disease other than influenza).
- ➔ If symptoms of illness are unknown for an absent student, DO NOT include this student in your count of ILI related absences.
