All children birth to 36 months old.

WHAT IS DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING?

Developmental screening looks for strengths and concerns in one or more of the five areas below:

- Cognitive: ability to learn and how a child learns
- Physical/Sensory: ability to move, see and hear
- Communication: ability to understand language and express needs
- Social or emotional: ability to relate with others
- Adaptive skills: ability to dress, eat and take care of themselves (Washington State Department of Early Learning, 2010)

WHY SCREEN EARLY?

Early support can make a big difference to your child's overall development.

WHEN TO SCREEN?

- ☑ Health Care Provider well visit check-ups.
- ☑ Anytime parent or caregiver has a concern.
