



Want to keep your kids cavity free?



The **Access to Baby & Child Dentistry (ABCD)** program offers preventive dental care for Medicaid–eligible children from birth up to age 6. The program emphasizes early access and their first visit to a dentist by age one or first tooth.

ABCD can improve your child’s oral health by:

- Finding a child-friendly dentist in your area
- Giving your child a great start in life by making sure all baby teeth are healthy
- Making going to the dentist visits a regular part of your child’s life
- Providing education about how to take care of your child’s oral health

Eligibility:

- Birth up to the 6th birthday
- Children living in Clark County
- Apple Health (Medicaid) eligible



Dental benefits:

- 2 dental exams yearly
- 3 fluoride varnish applications yearly
- 2 parent education sessions yearly
- Restorative care as needed

Early dental care can also prevent cavities, mouth pain and even chronic disease later in life.
