BYLAWS

I. NAME

The name of the neighborhood association shall be EAST FORK FRONTIER Neighborhood Association.

II. OBJECT

EAST FORK
The FRONTIER Neighborhood Association is established by the residents in order to unite the common interests and promote the welfare of the neighborhood. The EAST FORK FRONTIER Neighborhood Association shall concern itself with a variety of problems including, but not limited to, matters affecting livability and quality of the neighborhood and the community in general.

IV. MEMBERSHIP

EAST FORK
The membership of the FRONTIER Neighborhood Association is open to all residents, home owners, property owners, managers of multiple-family dwellings, profit, and non-profit organizations within the boundaries of this neighborhood association.

V. OFFICERS

EAST FORK
The officers of the FRONTIER Neighborhood Association shall be a president, vice president and a secretary/treasurer. The officers shall preside over all meetings, planning session, and activities of the EAST FORK FRONTIER Neighborhood Association.

VI. MEETINGS

EAST FORK
The FRONTIER Neighborhood Association shall meet at least once a year. The officers of the EAST FORK FRONTIER Neighborhood Association must meet not less than once each quarter to discuss neighborhood business. All decisions made by the officers must be confirmed by a meeting of the general membership. All decisions must be reached by majority vote of the membership attending the general meeting.

VII. EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board will include the officers and the committee chairpersons. All officers must reside within the boundaries of the neighborhood.

VIII. COMMITTEES

Special committees to address specific concerns may be appointed or disbanded by the officers as necessary.

IX. VOTING

All members eighteen (18) years and older are entitled to one (1) vote but must have attended a general meeting within a year prior to the current meeting.

X. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Officers shall be elected annually. Vacant positions shall be filled by general election whenever they occur.

XI. AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS

These bylaws may be amended at any general meeting by a two-thirds majority vote of those attending.

XII. FUNDING

Membership fees shall not bar any resident from membership or voting. Voluntary contributions, contracts, grants, subscriptions, or fund-raising activities may be used by the EAST FORK FRONTIER Neighborhood Association.
