We attended the Neighborhood Assoc. of Clark County's monthly meeting where Deputy Sherriff Rick Bishop did a presentation about the county's jails. Here's a few interesting factoids we learned:

- 1. Although national jail population decreased, female population has increased the last few years.
- 2. The county's bi-annual budget (24mo) is \$40M, and \$7M is spent on inmates' healthcare
- 3. The county focuses on retaining inmates charged with a felon, DUI and Domestic Violence as there is not enough room for everyone
