How they are assessed? Why they go up or down?

Please join us at the Sunnyside Neighborhood Association meeting Feb. 8 at 7 p.m. at the Barberton Grange at 9400 NE 72nd Avenue. We are pleased to announce that either our county assessor, Peter Van Nortwick, or our treasurer Alishia Topper will be presenting and answering your questions. This is your opportunity to learn about property taxes.

The Senior Exemption plan will also be explained. As pointed out in the Sunnyside NA October newsletter, the Washington State Legislature has made changes in the senior citizens, disabled people, and veterans exemption program. The income threshold has been changed, making more people eligible. One must apply to receive the exemption. The program may help you pay your property taxes. Under the exemption program your residence's assessed value is frozen and you will be exempt from excess and special levies resulting in a reduction in your property taxes.


