Submittal Checklist

The following checklist identifies information to be included. **All items** must be submitted before the submittal can be accepted. All submittals not determined to be complete will be returned to the applicant for corrections.

- Cover sheet
- Development Engineering application form
- Application fee
- Narrative – A detailed description of the existing conditions and proposal
- Submittal requirement checklist
- Plot plan drawing
 - The elevations, dimensions, location, extent, and slope of proposed grading, including building and driveway grades. Clearly show the location of cuts and fills
 - Show on the plan and describe in the narrative the stormwater, drainage patterns, and erosion control for the site, submitted in accordance with Chapter 3 of the Clark County Stormwater Manual at www.clark.wa.gov/public-works/stormwater-code-and-manual
 - Show on the plan any potential issues along the property line, such as impacts to a neighbor's drainage
- Estimate of the quantity of excavation and fill involved; identify the total cubic yards of excavation (cuts) and the amount of fill brought in from offsite
- Supplemental information, such as easements and right-of-way agreements
- SEPA, required for disturbing 1000 c.y. or more
- DAHP - Archaeological Predetermination, required for grading 500 c.y. or more
