## HERITAGE FARM PARKING LOT

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will construct a new parking lot on the west side of the Heritage Farm administration building at 1919 N.E. 78th St. in Hazel Dell. Clark County owns the 79-acre farm, which is the home to agricultural programs operated by several community organizations.

### WHY IS THE COUNTY DOING THIS WORK?

In 2009, Clark County developed a master plan for the farm site. A paved parking lot was included as part of the plan. The parking lot is needed now because of increasing use of the farm.

### WHAT WILL THE COUNTY DO AND WHEN?

Clark County has hired a local contractor, Thompson Bros. Excavating Inc. Construction will begin about mid-May and end in late summer 2016. Construction will include grading, installing curbs, pipe installation, paving, lighting and landscaping.

### WHAT SHOULD YOU EXPECT?

Construction will be on weekdays during daylight hours. Residents can expect to hear some construction noise.

### PROJECT FUNDING

About 89 percent of the project's budget will come from the state of Washington, with local funding providing the remaining 11 percent.
