





From Battle Ground - east on Main St, left on NE Grace Ave, right onto NE 10th St continuing onto NE Heisson Rd, right onto NE 244th St continuing onto NE Palmer Rd, left on NE 249th St to parking.

3. Bells Mntn & Tarbell Trails	Primitive	8, 24 miles	Moderate to Difficult	N	Y	Y	N	N	N	Y	Y	Y	Bells Mntn: North on SR 503 past Battle Ground. East on Rock Creek Rd, continue onto Lucia Falls Rd. Parking available at Hantwick Rd trailhead. Tarbell: Follow Lucia Falls Rd, right onto Sunset Falls Rd, right on NE 312 Ave, right onto Dole Valley Rd
4. Bonneville Dam Trail	Primitive	2 miles	Moderate to Difficult	N	Y	Y	N	N	N	N	Y	N	Hwy 14 East to Bonneville Dam. Park at rest stop on left (north). Trail starts NW corner near restrooms. 1.5 miles up, trail joins the Pacific Crest Trail.
5. Captain William Clark Park Trail	Primitive	6 miles	Easy	N	Y	N	N	N	N	N	Y	N	32nd and Index, Washougal WA. State Route 14 east from Vancouver, passed Camas. South on S 32nd Ave. Parking at the end of the road.

Turn left (east) 7 miles on the left is main park entrance. Proceed on Homan Rd. 1/2 mile to turn around. Park before cul-de-sac. Do not block turn around.

12. Whipple Creek Park Trail	Primitive	5 + miles	Moderate to Difficult	N	Y	N	N	N	N	N	Y	Y	From I-5: west on NW 179th St, south on NW 21st Ave. Parking at the end of the road.
