



## Clark County 2015 Stormwater Manual Implementation Summary of Procedure

This procedure statement documents discussions and decisions from Public Works, Community Development, and Prosecuting Attorney's office. Implementation of stormwater regulations require staff to work through specific details of the regulations with applicants. The purpose is to ensure consistent application of county requirements. These procedure statements also document decisions for future reference.

### Procedure statement #2015-015 – May 2020 Bayfilter™ Acceptance for Private Development Projects

#### Background

In 2016, Clark County approved the use of the Bayfilter™ treatment BMP for projects where the developer would be the owner. At the time, there was concern about allowing the Bayfilter™ use in residential subdivisions for a variety of reasons, mainly uncertainty and concerns about the ability to maintain them.

There are now several ADS-certified contractors that can maintain Bayfilter™ units in Clark County.

#### Finding

Bayfilter™ BMP units are now allowed for stormwater residential subdivision projects where the unit will be owned and operated by the subdivision residents. Installation, inspections and maintenance must follow the standards referenced in the 2016 approval and most recent GULD.
