
Vote for one choice for each contest or ballot measure. If you vote for more than one choice for that contest or ballot measure, no votes will be counted for that contest or ballot measure.

**WHEN RETURNING YOUR BALLOT**

Put a first class stamp (\$0.49) on the envelope and mail it on or before Election Day, Tuesday, August 1. Your ballot must be postmarked no later than Election Day, so check the pick-up schedule on the mailbox or confirm Election Day hours with the post office.

If you return your ballot to a drop site location, it must be returned by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 1, for it to be counted.

 Proposition No. 2**  
 Emergency Medical Program Excess Levy

The Town Council, Town of Yacolt, Clark  
 County, Washington, adopted Resolution  
 No. 556, referring to the voters the  
 proposition described herein. This  
 proposition allows the electors of the  
 Town of Yacolt, to authorize a one-year  
 excess levy to be made in 2017 for  
 collection in 2018 in the total amount of  
 \$133,786, at an approximate tax rate of  
 \$1.40 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation,  
 with the proceeds of such excess levy to  
 be used for maintenance, operation and  
 staff salaries for the North Country  
 Emergency Medical Service for an  
 estimated three (3) year period.

The Board of County Councilors of Clark  
 County, Washington adopted Resolution  
 No. 2017-04-09, referring to the voters the  
 foregoing proposition. This proposition  
 allows the electors of Clark County  
 Emergency Medical Service District No. 1  
 to authorize a one-year excess levy to be  
 made in 2017 for collection in 2018 in the  
 total amount of \$2,079,195, at an  
 approximate tax rate of \$1.40 per \$1,000  
 of assessed valuation, with the proceeds  
 of such excess levy to be used for  
 maintenance, operation and staff salaries  
 for the North Country Emergency Medical  
 Service for an estimated three (3) year  
 period.
