- 6. Other business to come before the Commission:
 - a. Appeal hearing scheduled for April 23rd Secretary Harrington Smith reviewed the anticipated process for the appeal hearing set for Thursday April 23rd. Mr. Hulsey will be the first appellant to testify and then the witness for the Sheriff's Office will present his case followed by questions from Commissioners and legal counsel. Mr. Johnson will be the second appellant and a similar process to the first hearing will take place. The 2 appellants have separate Webex meeting codes. The secretary pointed out that the hearings will be recorded, as all hearings have been audio recorded in the past. Webex has a recording function and the secretary has to obtain agreement from the appellants to use that method of recording.
 - b. Response to COVID-19 Update PST Secretary Harrington Smith shared that Public Safety Testing has canceled public testing through May 4th, however they are working on providing individual remote testing. The secretary said that if the stay home/stay safe order continues past 5/4 it would be advantageous to have a conversation with the Sheriff's Office leadership about whether or not to accept remote testing scores, etc. PST worked with the test authors to put in safeguards in order to minimize risks.
 - c. Recruitment update
 - i. The recent Lateral Deputy Sheriff interviews were conducted via Skype, with the panel members together in the Sheriff's Office, each candidate was contacted via Skype.
 - d. Rule Edit for Civil Service Rule 10.05 to reflect WA HOUSE BILL 1750 "Rule of 5" that goes into effect June 11, 2020
 - 10.05 CERTIFICATION
 - c. Order of certification from promotional and open eligibility lists.

(1) If a vacancy is to be filled from an eligibility list, the Secretary shall certify to the appointing authority the names of the five three highest ranking eligible candidates that are qualified and available for employment. When necessary, and upon request of the appointing authority and with approval of the Secretary, names may be granted provisional certification pending the final outcome of the background investigation.
