- Government Social Media Conference is an annual event drawing about 1,000 government social media professionals.
- The annual Golden Post Award program honors outstanding use of social media by local and state government agencies.
 - Nearly 300 entries for 10 awards
- In February, Public Health was named one of five finalists for a Golden Post Award for the best use of social media in an emergency for Facebook presence during the measles outbreak in 2019.
