

Leichner Campus & Fields Master Plan – Real Estate Expert Panel 04/10 11am to 2pm

Clark County has begun a master planning process that will help guide decisions about the future use of county-owned property at 9411 NE 94th Avenue. The county agreed to purchase the 120-acre site from private owners in December 2012 with the intent of encouraging job-creating businesses to locate on a 35-acre portion of the property currently zoned for light industrial development.

Maul Foster Alongi is leading the team that will prepare concepts for the future redevelopment of the Leichner Campus Master Plan area. These concepts will be driven by market demand analysis and the environmental restrictions inherent to the former site use.

We would like to invite you to help inform the outcome of this significant property, and to shape the future development of this part of Clark County. The County is hosting a panel of select experts in the real estate development, construction, and finance fields to review preliminary findings and provide strategic advice for the County's disposition strategy.
