DESCRIPTION: *Clark County Unified Development Code (Title 40.350.015.E) Amendments (CPZ2020-00013 Pedestrian Accessway Code Amendment)* – The proposal is to amend the text of the Pedestrian/Bicycle Circulation Standards (CCC Chapter 40.350.015) to require pedestrian accessways on developments that are adjacent to collector and arterial classified roadways to provide pedestrian connections to the streets.

ACTION REQUESTED: It is requested that the County Council amend the text of the Pedestrian/Bicycle Circulation Standards Code (CCC Chapter 40.350.015) to require development adjacent to collector and arterial classified roadways to provide pedestrian accessways when lots within the developments are greater than one quarter mile from the collector and arterial roadway.
