DATE: September 15, 2020

REQUESTED ACTION: Approve publication of the Notice to Contractors requesting bids for construction of Northeast 10th Avenue from Northeast 149th Street to Northeast 154th Street Project No. 323322.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

This project will improve Northeast 10th Avenue between Northeast 149th Street and Northeast 154th Street by widening the roadway to include two travel lanes, a center left-turn lane, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes. The work will include constructing a new culvert crossing for a tributary of Whipple Creek, completing stormwater and utility improvements, and installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Northeast 10th Avenue and Northeast 149th Street.

Project plans and specifications are complete, and the project is ready for bidding. The project will be advertised for bids once WSDOT funding approval is received (anticipated in September or October 2020).

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project supports the council's policy of providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program, 2020 Annual Construction Program (No. 2) and the 2020 Budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) included two work sessions and a hearing with the Clark County Council; presentations to Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, and neighborhood associations. The TIP was also displayed and discussed at several public open houses, at the Clark County Fair and on the county website. The TIP has also been the subject of a digital media campaign across multiple digital media platforms. A State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) review provided an additional opportunity for public comment.

In addition, this project has been included in mailings, fair exhibits and open houses associated with the previously completed Northeast 10th Avenue bridge and the more recently undertaken Northeast 179th Street improvements. An additional online public information meeting for this project is scheduled for November of this year, and additional mailings will be sent out as construction gets underway in 2021. As construction gets closer, Public Works will send a news release that will be

posted to the Public Works website and all social media platforms. A legal ad will be published in the newspaper of record prior to any road closures.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on _____, 2020 for: **Project No. 323322, NE 10th Avenue (NE 149th St – NE 154th St).**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Improve roadway to include two travel lanes, center left-turn lane, sidewalks, bicycle lanes and traffic signal. Work to be performed includes clearing, grubbing, excavation, grading and paving; the construction of water, sanitary sewer and storm water systems, including stormwater facilities; curb and gutter, sidewalks, ground improvements, retaining walls, culvert, signing and striping, signal installation and other work.

Primary bid items: Flaggers; Excavation Incl. Haul (Roadway, Earthwork, Stormwater Facility); Gravel Borrow Incl. Haul; Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA Cl. ½ In. 58H-22; Structural Earth Wall; St. Str. Plate Pipe 5 Gage 204 In. Diam.; Topsoil Type A; Cement Conc. Sidewalk; Traffic Signal System; ITS; Ground Improvements; 30-In. D.I. Watermain Pipe w/ Type R Restoration.

Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.




- This project will improve Northeast 10th Avenue between Northeast 149th Street and Northeast 154th Street by:

 - Constructing a new culvert crossing over a tributary of Whipple Creek, including retaining walls.
 - Installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Northeast 10th Avenue and Northeast 149th Street.
 - Completing stormwater improvements, including a detention pond.
 - Adding a sanitary sewer force main for CRWWD and a water main for CPU.
