1. **TOPIC:** Title 40 Code Amendment: Pedestrian Accessways

4. **TIMING CONSIDERATIONS:** Staff would like the opportunity to discuss the proposed changes to the Title 40 code amendment with the Clark County Council prior to the November 17th public hearing.

5. **DESIRED RESULTS:** This work session would provide an opportunity for the council to ask questions and provide feedback on the proposed code changes prior to the public hearing. This format allows for a more in-depth discussion between the council members and staff.

6. **IMPACTS (COMMUNITY/FINANCIAL/STAFF/OTHER):** The code amendment would require pedestrian accessways when development is near collectors and arterials. Certain incentives associated with single family zoning districts are proposed for accommodating pedestrian accessways.

7. **POLICY IMPLICATIONS:** This is a proposed changed to Clark County Code 40.350.015 and 40.220.010.

8. **ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED:** On July 22, 2020, the Clark County Council authorized staff to proceed with an amendment to the Clark County Code. To date, staff has received recommendations from the Development Engineering Advisory Board and the Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee. The Planning Commission is scheduled to consider the code amendment on October 15th. The code amendment would require pedestrian accessways be built when development is near collectors and arterials. Certain incentives associated with single family zoning districts are proposed for accommodating the accessways. 9. **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Council authorization to proceed with the scheduled November 17th public hearing to adopt the proposed code updates.
