About the VLCFA and VLCFA Board:

The Vancouver Library Capital Facility Area (VLCFA) is an independent taxing area formed by voter approval in the Nov. 8, 2005 election. The boundaries of the VLCFA are the same boundaries as the city of Vancouver.

The governing body of the VLCFA is comprised of three members of the Board of Clark County Councilors. The VLCFA Board contracted with Fort Vancouver Regional Library District through an Interlocal agreement to carry out three building projects approved by voters in the Sept. 19, 2006 bond election. These projects included construction of the new Main library, new Cascade Park library and technology improvements at the Vancouver Mall library.
