Thank you for your comments. I am confirming receipt and will add your email to the county's Shoreline Master Program periodic review project record.

It looks like much of your documentation is focused on areas along Burnt Bridge Creek, which largely falls within the City of Vancouver boundaries. The county's shoreline master program jurisdiction only covers those areas along the creek that are outside of the City of Vancouver city limits. I would recommend, if you have not done so already, that you also share your comments with the city (cayla.cothron@cityofvancouver.us).

It also seems like some of your concerns may be considered environmental public health issues. If you have not already done so, you can file a report with the health department here: <https://clark.wa.gov/public-health/report-health-concern>.

Clark County paying \$3 million over six years for violating the Clean Water Act with payments that Started in June 2015 for \$500,000/yr


