REQUESTED ACTION: Approve publication of the Notice to Contractors requesting bids for construction and reconstruction of curb ramps for the 2020 ADA Compliance Group 2 Project (CRP No. 391322) and the 2021 Preservation ADA Improvements Group 3 Project (CRP No. 391422).

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

The 2020 ADA Compliance Group 2 project will construct or upgrade sidewalk curb ramps and install detectable warning surfaces to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act regulations.

This work includes constructing or reconstructing ten ramps at seven locations throughout Clark County:

- Three locations on Northeast Hazel Dell Avenue
- Two locations on Northeast 107th Avenue
- One location on Northeast 58th Avenue
- One location on Northeast 66th Avenue

The 2021 Preservation ADA Improvements Group 3 project will install detectable warning surfaces on 89 ramps throughout the county. The detectable warning surfaces provide guidance for visually impaired pedestrians.

This project will advertise for bids once the contract documents are completed.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project supports the council's policy of providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program, 2020 Annual Construction Program (No. 20) and the 2020 Budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Public outreach to date has included communication with affected property owners regarding the purpose of the project, information gathering and potential impacts. Future outreach with property owners will occur prior to construction.

Development of the 2020-2025 TIP included a Clark County Council work session, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, Public Open Houses, Clark County Fair and neighborhood associations. A State Environmental Policy Act

(SEPA) review provided an additional opportunity for public comment. A public hearing before the Clark County Council is the final step in public involvement for TIP adoption.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on _____, 2020 for: **Project No. 0000279, CRP 391322, 2020 ADA Compliance, Group 2, Project No. 0000286, CRP 391422, 2021 Preservation ADA Improvements, Group 3.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: The 2020 ADA Compliance Group 2 and the 2021 Preservation ADA Improvements Group 3 projects will construct or reconstruct sidewalk curb ramps and install detectable warning surfaces to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regulations.

Primary bid items: Construction Surveying; Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA CL. 1/2 In. PG58H-22; Cement Conc. Traffic Curb and Gutter; Cement Conc. Pedestrian Curb; Cement Conc. Sidewalk; Cement Conc. Curb Ramp, Detectable Warning Surface and Traffic Control.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid




opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.




