Dear Ms. Rayworth:

Your voter registration has been challenged by Craig A. Rayworth, based on the belief that you are not a U.S. citizen and are not entitled to vote. Copies of the documents and supplemental documents filed by the challenger are enclosed.

If this challenge is correct and you are not a U.S. citizen, you must complete the cancellation form enclosed and return it to our office no later than Dec. 10. A postage-paid envelope is also enclosed for your convenience. You may return it by mail, attention to Cathie Garber, at Clark County Elections, PO Box 8815, Vancouver, WA 98666. You may also fax the cancellation form to our office at 564-397-2394, or email it to cathie.garber@clark.wa.gov. If we receive your cancellation form before this date, no hearing challenging your voter registration will be held.

Pursuant to RCW 29A.08.810, a hearing regarding the challenge to your voter registration has been scheduled for December 15, 2020, at 2 p.m. at the Clark County Elections/Auto License Building, 1408 Franklin Street, Conference Room 226, Vancouver, WA 98660. The County Auditor will preside over the hearing. A voter registration challenge hearing is an administrative hearing, not a court proceeding. The hearing is open to the public. The challenger must prove by clear and convincing evidence that your registration is invalid. You can respond by either participating in person, or submitting written testimony by declaration. A sample declaration is attached. If you decide to respond by declaration, it must be received in our office prior to the hearing. We ask that you please provide us all evidence before the meeting, so the County Auditor may be prepared before the hearing. If you do not participate in the hearing, a decision will be made based on all available information.

You may provide evidence that shows you are a U.S. citizen and are entitled to vote.
