# Working together

Children and youth with special health care needs (CYSHCN) program provides support to families who have children birth to 18 years old with a chronic health condition.

A few examples of special health conditions children may have are:

- Autism spectrum disorder
- Behavioral disorders
- Cerebral palsy
- Cleft lip and/or palate
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Down syndrome
- Gross/fine motor delays
- Speech/language delays
- Social/emotional delays
