

#### CHANGING LIVES FOR GENERATIONS

Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) is an evidence-based home visiting program for first-time moms conducted throughout the US and other countries. It is now also being offered in Clark and Cowlitz counties to women who have had previous live births.

- Women receive their own registered nurse who visits them in their home or location of their choice during pregnancy and through the child's second birthday.
- Nurses provide guidance and support to promote maternal and child health.

#### WHAT IS NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP?

Nurse-Family Partnership is a program with decades of rigorous evidence that improves maternal and child health when focused on vulnerable women with no previous live births.

#### **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

It is free to eligible women!

## WHO CAN ENROLL?

Low-income pregnant women with previous live births who are at risk for poor birth or child-health outcomes are now eligible in Clark and Cowlitz counties.

## WHY INVITE MULTIPAROUS MOTHERS INTO THE PROGRAM?

Nurse-Family Partnership will now serve both first-time mothers and those with previous live births in selected communities throughout the US. The new work is designed to lay the groundwork for ensuring that NFP nurses can achieve similar outcomes with vulnerable women who have had previous live births.

## WHAT WILL THE MOTHER RECEIVE?

The mother will receive home-visits from a registered nurse from pregnancy through child age two.

The nurse will:

- Promote mother's health and well-being;
- · Help mother have a healthy pregnancy;
- Help mother promote her child's health and development.
