

DIAPERS/PULL-UPS FOR CHILDREN 3 AND OLDER (MEDICAID)

Step 1:

In order to be eligible to order diapers or pull-ups for Medicaid clients who are three years or older, they must first have a medical diagnosis related to incontinence.

Step 2:

Contact the PCP office. Ask the doctor to write a prescription for Medicaid paid diapers. He/she will need to include the following:

- Child's Name and Diagnosis
- Diaper Size
- Diaper Amount Needed per Month (can ask for up to 200/month)
- Name of Medical Supply Store that parent wants to use
 - Please note that each time the child needs a larger size, all the above steps will need to be repeated.

Step 3:

The PCP will get the OK from medical insurance and then send the prescription to the medical supply store.

- If mom has a certain medical supply store she plans to use, perfect. She just needs to make sure they will take this Medicaid prescription.
- Many use My Medical Supply at 888-441-1312; fax: 866-583-9296
- Some places will ship out the diapers and others have clients pick them up.

^{***}Most doctors know this process. If not, they will need to be informed of the process needed.
