The Clark County Sheriff's Office only accepts alarm permit registrations for locations within the unincorporated area of Clark County. For all other jurisdictions, please check with your local law enforcement agency for registration requirements.

To apply for a security alarm permit, submit a completed registration form along with the \$20.00 registration fee to the Clark County Sheriff's Office. Please make your check or money order payable to the Clark County Sheriff's Office.

The following information is a summary of Clark County's Security Alarm Ordinance. The ordinance, Clark County Code Chapter 5.60, is available online at www.clark.wa.gov.

REGISTRATION

- Clark County Code Chapter 5.60 requires that all private security alarm systems in the unincorporated Clark County jurisdiction must be registered with the Clark County Sheriff's Office <u>before</u> activation.
- An annual twenty-dollar (\$20.00) fee is required for the registration of all alarm systems. Economically disadvantaged exemption: Primary residential alarm users who are eligible to participate in a federally funded food stamp program may request exemption from the permit fee. Please contact the Alarm Coordinator at 564-397-2127 for more information.
- If reason exists to believe an alarm system is not being used, or maintained in a proper manner, an inspection may be required. Inspections and corrective action shall be the responsibility of the alarm user or alarm service company.

PENALTIES

Clark County Code 5.60 includes the following penalty structure:

Failure to register	\$100 and possible disconnection
1 st false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$50
2 nd false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$100
3 rd false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$150
4 th false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$200
5 th false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$250
6 th false alarm* response in a 12-month period	\$300 and possible deactivation

^{*}A false alarm is the activation of any alarm system by other than a forced entry, attempted forced entry, unlawful entry, or actual burglary or robbery at the alarm site, and at a time when no robbery or burglary or other crime is being committed or attempted at the alarm site.
