**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Clark County Council will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, May 13, 2025, at 1:00 p.m.** in the Councilors Hearing Room, sixth floor, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St., Vancouver, Wash. to consider the following:

1. Amendment to Ordinance 2022-07-01: A proposal to consider repeal of subsection 5 of section 2 of Ordinance 2022-07-01 related to CPZ 2021-00006 Chelatchie Bluff which added a Surface Mining Overlay (SMO) to four parcels totaling 330 acres. This proposed action is in response to the Court of Appeals decision affirming the Growth Management Hearings Board Final Order that concluded that the county's action to add the overlay did not comply with the Growth Management Act and is invalid as interfering with the GMA goals due to a SEPA violation.
