A RESOLUTION thanking the Cowlitz Indian Tribe for its timely and generous donation benefiting Columbia River Mental Health Services and the mental health community of Clark County.

WHEREAS, Columbia River Mental Health Services provides essential services to southwest Washington; and

WHEREAS, such services include treatment for opioid use disorders at the NorthStar Clinic, serving 850 patients; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2025, Columbia River Mental Health Services experienced a financial crisis and announced closure of such essential services, including at North Star Clinic; and

WHEREAS, the Cowlitz Indian Tribe, on April 3, 2025, donated \$1.6 million to Columbia River Mental Health Services enabling the agency to continue service at the NorthStar Clinic;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COUNCIL:
