# Report on Policy Issues

Presented by Jordan Boege, Senior Policy Analyst

- DNR Natural Conservation SWAP Program
  - Jordan provided an overview of the program, and stated if the Council chose to participate, they
    could recommend a specific location for DNR to consider, though DNR will be the final
    decisionmaker on what areas are conserved through the program.
  - o Jordan went over the details of the parcel on Larch Mountain that could be recommended if the Council decides to participate in the SWAP Program.
  - o Council wanted additional information and feedback from County Staff before moving forward. This will be brought back for discussion at Council Time next week.
- 2026 Legislative Priorities
  - o Jordan outlined the agenda for the Legislative Priorities meetings.
  - o Feedback was given by Council:
    - Include the work that Board of Health has done on Prenatal Care for Medicaid Patients
    - Modify the structure to allow emphasis for the highest priorities, allowing a pause for discussion from the legislators
    - Give time for the legislators to present their priorities
  - o Jordan will finalize the presentation this week utilizing the feedback received and send to Council for review.
