WHO St. Paul:

People Served = 48,

Total Bed Nights = 3,780,

Opened 11/1/2024 to 3/31/2025

Arts School:

People Served = 139,

Total Bed Nights = 4,582,

Opened 12/14/2024 to 3/31/2025

Chkalov Building supported by Beautiful Savior Lutheran:

People Served = 66,

Total Bed Nights = 1,262,

Opened 12/14/2024 to 3/31/2025 (on Sat, Sun, Mon, & Tuesdays)

Immanuel Lutheran:

People Served = 53,

Total Bed Nights = 909,

Opened 12/18/2024 to 3/28/2025 (on Wed, Thr & Fridays)

Living Hope Severe Weather Shelter:

People Served = 205,

Total Bed Nights = 1,484,
