- **WHEREAS,** this council acknowledges that there are many in our community who are experiencing fear, especially for our communities of color; and
- **WHEREAS,** Clark County is dedicated to ensuring all community members have equal opportunities to participate actively in community life, with fair access to resources and services presented in ways everyone can understand; and
- **WHEREAS,** Clark County wants to inspire our community members to express thoughts, ideas and concerns openly and honestly and to treat each other with courtesy and respect without personal attacks or inappropriate behavior;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COUNCIL:

The Clark County Council is dedicated to promoting unity in our county and commits to be deliberate and intentional in its efforts to engage one another and the community in constructive, honest, and substantive dialogue in order to improve the quality of life for our residents and create a culture where violence has no place in our politics. The council urges all Clark County residents to work together toward our shared goal of a county where all can flourish in a spirit of mutual respect and cooperation. Together we can be the foundation for a cohesive and supportive community where all individuals feel valued, heard, safe, and connected.
