Why form a school Green Team?

Green Teams are the foundation to becoming an EarthGen-certified school. Having a Green Team ensures sustainability projects create long-lasting change and can be supported throughout the years.

Planning a Green Team

Choose who will be part of your green team. Consider teachers, administrators, custodial staff, parents, community, and local partners. How will you recruit them?

Decide when and where you will meet. Consider meeting during class, before/after school, during lunch, or during a study hall period. For your first session, use the Green Team Brainstorm sheets.

Explain why your campus needs a green team. Relate your broad sustainability goals back to your school's values.

Learn how to form a club on campus. This can be an activity to do with newly recruited members. The Green Team will most likely need permission from the administration and an advisor to be an official club.

Promote the Green Team. Use our Green Team flyer template (options are below) to advertise the club. Have the students attend the first Green Team meeting to brainstorm project ideas and assess the participation and commitment levels.

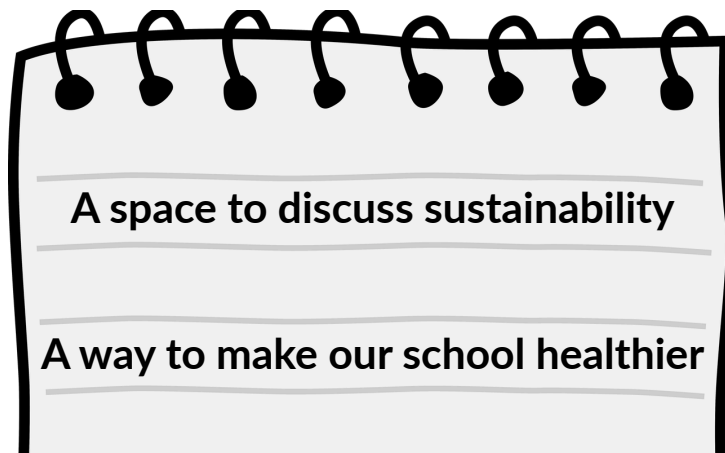
