Title	Free & Simple Composting, We Compost Community Hubs
Description	<p>We Compost offers all Clark County residents free and convenient access to composting service through established drop-off locations, or community hubs, across the county.</p> <p><i>Participants are eligible for a kitchen compost pail at no cost.</i></p> <p>We Compost Community Hubs connect the community by increasing access to composting for people who live in multifamily residences or outside of the curbside organics service areas. The program inspires residents to transform their food waste disposal practices to lessen climate impacts and support Washington’s organics management goals. In 2024, over 50,000 pounds of food waste was diverted from the landfill through the We Compost program.</p>
Length	15-45 minutes (can be tailored to audience needs).

Target Audience	All residents in Clark County, particularly useful for residents within high density housing areas and multifamily residents and for residents living within close proximity of an existing hub site.

Title	Organics 101 – Curbside Composting Done Right
Description	If you live within Vancouver or Ridgefield city limits, you can add food scraps to your yard debris cart. During this class, learn about this optional program including:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is and is not accepted in the organics cart and why. • The benefit of keeping food scraps out of the garbage. • How to maintain your cart and pail to keep them clean. • Where the yard debris and food scraps go after leaving the curb.
