2026 Timeline

March 11th & March 18th - Finish 1st Reading

March 18th – Begin 2nd Readings

- There are 11 meetings between March 18th and May 27th
 1. 4 Per Meeting March 18th-April 1st to get through 12 already passed
 2. 3 Per meeting April 8th- April 29th will yield an additional 12
 3. 1-2 Per meeting, starting May 6th, to shift focus to outreach reports and subcommittee presentations would allow 4-8 more
- Prioritize Amendments that require more in-depth research up front to give subcommittees time
- Subcommittees will need approximately 4 weeks to allow notice and then meet at least twice, with some amendments possibly taking longer

April 8th – Begin Subcommittee Presentations and Form Drafting Committee

- We have 13 meetings between April 8th and July 1st
 1. 1 Per Meeting April 8th -April 29th to get through 1st 4
 2. 2 Per Meeting May 6th – June 24th to yield 16
 3. Realistic capacity, unless we extend the meeting length, is 20
- The last to present on July 1st would need a finalized proposal prepared at the time of presentation, so ideally, we should pace to finish by June 24th

May 27th – Last date for 2nd Readings

June 24th – Last date for Subcommittee Presentation

July 1st – Subcommittee Deadline For Drafting Proposal

July 22nd – Final Vote on Resolutions

August 1st to November 3rd -Focus Shifts Completely To Outreach

- Slow Meeting Pace(Once a month to Every 2 weeks)

August Through December

- Continue reviewing proposals that have been deferred to the 2027 ballot
