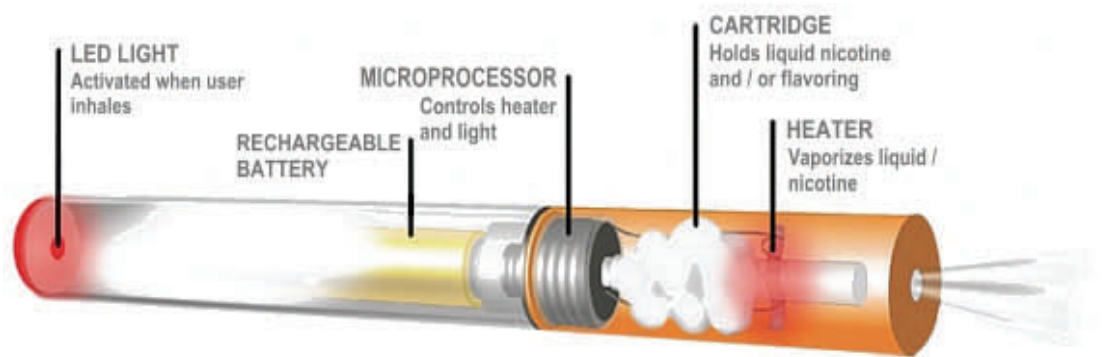


Vapor Devices

AKA e-cigs • e-cigars • e-hookah • e-joints • e-pens • e-pipes • tank systems • hookah pens • vape-pens • vape-pipes • vaporizers • MODs • tanks • electronic nicotine delivery device

WHAT IS IT?

- ➔ A battery-powered cartridge filled with liquid is heated to produce an aerosol
- ➔ Can easily be adapted or purchased to use with other drugs like marijuana or heroin¹

NICOTINE

Nicotine is poisonous



A few drops on the skin can be dangerous. If ingested, it can be fatal.

NO FDA regulation **NO** disclosure of ingredients **NO** quality control
NO childproof packaging **NO** approval as an effective way to quit smoking

Secondhand Aerosol

Contains nicotine, formaldehyde, propylene glycol, and ultrafine particles that penetrate the lungs. May also contain other substances known to cause cancer: benzene, cadmium, lead and nickel²

Whatever you call it, don't call it safe
